2. General Information

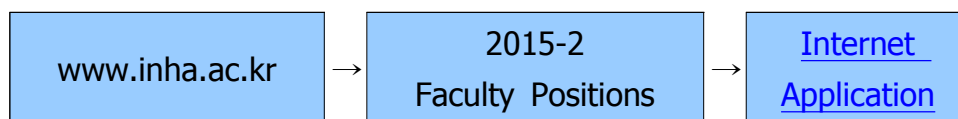
1. Scheduled date of appointment: September 1, 2015
2. Please refer to Inha University policies and guidelines concerning employment for the applying positions.
3. A Ph. D. is required for all academic fields.
4. Applicants must be legally eligible for employment according to private university regulations in Korea.
5. Applicants must be able to teach at least one course in English each semester. For applicants in law, there is no obligation to teach in English.
6. Special research allowances are provided if employed.
7. Conference calls or video interviews may be available for international applicants.

3. Qualifications

1. Mechanical engineering applicants' undergraduate major should be related to mechanical engineering fields such as mechanical, automotive, aerospace, and materials engineering. Materials and Processing is limited to the mechanical engineering materials. Mechatronics and robotics experts may apply for the Automatic Control.
2. Ppuri Technology (Structural Materials) applicants must major in metallic materials.
3. Required qualifications for RF Integrated Circuit Design candidates include: 1) Semiconductor integrated circuit design for radio frequency, 2) able to teach semiconductor device and integrated circuit design class, 3) teaching skills in English.
4. System Software applicant must have a Ph.D in Computer Science or Computer Engineering.
5. For Physical Oceanography, applicants' final academic degree should be from an oceanography related department and ocean circulation majors are preferred.
6. International Business Transaction applicants need to lecture International Business in English and write SSCI paper.
7. For Modern Korean Literature, preference is given to candidates with A&HCI and SSCI publications Preference is given to candidates who can teach East Asian comparative literature. Preference is given to candidates who majored in modern Korean literature.
8. For Art Administration, the candidate is expected to teach and perform integrated art administration, marketing and public project related to art and required to be capable of teaching art criticism and theories.
9. For Women's Health Nursing/Nursing Management, applicants must have more than two years of work experience in nursing practice. Those who can lecture in English are preferred.

4. Online Application

1. Applicants can access the online application form from 10:00 AM (Seoul time), Thursday, March 5, 2015 until 5:00 PM Friday, March 13, 2014.

4. Applicants must apply during the specified time and dates.

5. First Submission of Documents

1. Submission Period: 10:00 AM (Seoul time), Monday, March 23, 2015 through 5:00 PM, Wednesday, March 25, 2015.
2. Submission Desk: Main Building 2nd floor Conference Room, Inha University (University Main nistration Building #201)
3. All materials must be submitted in person after completing the online application form. Submission by post is not allowed.
4. Documents to be submitted
 - (1) Two representative research achievements from the comprehensive list

▷ List of representative research achievements (See attachment)

- Two representative research achievements should be selected from the comprehensive list compiled as part of online application.

★ A doctoral dissertation is acceptable as a representative research achievement, but it should have been published within the past three years.

★ An article in a journal may be selected as a representative research achievement only if the applicant is the first or corresponding author.

▷ Six copies each of representative research achievements

- Copies must include all contents from the cover page to the last page. The author's name and affiliation should be deleted or erased. (Make copies after deleting or erasing them.)

★ Documents written in a language other than Korean or English must be translated into Korean or English and signed by the applicant.

(2) A copy of all of the research achievements

- ▷ One copy each of all of the research achievements on the comprehensive list compiled as part of online application
 - Journal articles: cover, abstract, pages with the name of the journal, publication date, volume number, author's name, and page numbers
 - Books: cover, table of contents, preface, a portion of the text (first 3-5 pages), pages with publication date, (chapter) author's name, a proof of revision
 - Patents: copies of any patents received (Patent applications will not be considered.)

★ All publications should be submitted in the same order as the list entered as part of online application.

(3) Copies of undergraduate and graduate diplomas along with the original

- A translation should be attached if the original is not in Korean or English.

(4) One official copy each of undergraduate and graduate transcripts

- A translation should be attached if the original is not in Korean or English.

(5) Letter of Consent (See attachment)

(6) A minimum of two letters of recommendation, including one from an advising professor

Important Reminder

- Two representative research achievements (publications) are required. Applications will not be accepted without them.
- A doctoral dissertation published within the past three years can be included in the list of publications. However, a dissertation is not acceptable as a separate research achievement if any part of it has been published in a different form such as a journal article.
- The publication date of all of the materials to be submitted should be between April 2012 - March 2015. Books and articles in press will not be considered.
- Only the publications listed at the time of online application will be reviewed.
- Letters of recommendation can be submitted by e-mail or in person at the submission desk. Those letters have to be signed and sealed unless submitted by e-mail. When submitted by e-mail, those letters need to be sent by the recommender directly to the following e-mail : newfaculty@inha.ac.kr. If letters of recommendation are not received by the date of submission, your submission cannot be completed.

6. Second Submission of Documents

1. Results of the 1st phase of the selection process and the schedule for the 2nd phase will be notified individually via email.
2. The following documents must be submitted for the 2nd phase of the selection process:
 - (1) A statement of research and teaching goals and plans, including possible courses that the applicant can teach and suggestions for new courses

- (2) Proof of previous employment for each item listed on the resume
 - Applicants who already submitted it at the 1st phase do not have to submit it again.

2. 2nd submission of documents : April 21(Tue) - 22(Wed), 2015
3. 2nd phase(open lecture & interview) : April 27(Mon) - May 1(Fri), 2015
 - The details will be informed in the 2nd submission of documents.
4. Result of the 2nd phase : May 8(Fri), 2015
5. 3rd phase(final interview) : May 19(Tue) - May 21(Thu), 2015
 - * The above schedule is subject to change.

8. Additional Information

1. Candidates who have outstanding research achievements are eligible for special research environments.
2. Inha University holds the right to cancel faculty appointments resulting from false information or forged documents.
3. Information entered during the online application process can be revised throughout the application period.
4. Applicants cannot apply for more than one position at Inha University. Multiple applications by the same applicant will invalidate all of his or her applications.
5. Application will be rejected unless all of the documents are submitted during the specified dates.
6. Applicants will be informed of the results of each stage of the review process individually via email.
7. If qualified applicants are not determined, the position may be left vacant.
8. Submitted documents will not be returned to applicants.
